May 18, 2016

The May 18, 2016, Board of Directors meeting of the Kiwanis Club of Bremerton was held at the Bremerton United Way Office.

Members present included Sunny Wheeler, Stephanie Blotzer, Bill Enger, Rob Schneider, Bob Morgan, Bud Cole, Pam Crowe, Justin Ksen and Darroll Clark. Beverley Luckey-Short attended as a guest. Our special guest was Lt. Gov. Melanie Bozak.

President Sunny Wheeler called the meeting to order at 6:15 pm.

Secretary's Report:

Minutes from the April 28, 2016, Special Board Meeting were read and approved. The monthly report was also reviewed and approved as presented.

At this time, a break was taken from our normal board meeting and Sunny asked board members to introduce themselves including length of time in Kiwanis to Lt. Gov. Melanie Bozak.

Treasurer's Report:

This report was tabled in the absence of Treasurer Tim Lavin.

Bills were presented for payment approval as follows: Beverley, food basket \$91.31; Key Club Lt. Gov. ICON, expense \$500.00. Approved.

Beverley reported she is planning a cookie auction and picnic to raise additional funds to support the Key Club Lt. Gov.

After discussion it was agreed a \$500.00 contribution would be made to Camp Beausite and \$475.00 to Kitsap Adult Center for Education.

Old Business:

Beverley presented a budget for the 2016 Blackberry Festival with an estimated profit of \$10,935.00. The pie and ice cream price would be increased from \$5.00 to \$6.00. 450 pies and 288 scones will be ordered.

\$3,100 has been pledged or received in hole sponsorships for the golf tournament according to Rob. Our past presidents will sponsor a hole also.

Background checks for our youth advisors, Bev, Dennis and Darroll, will be required by the national Kiwanis office starting the 2016 - 2017 administrative year with a \$25 fee for each one.

New Business:

Darroll presented a list of upcoming Key Club events that were approved. (A copy of these events is attached to the Secretary's file).

Stephanie's Builders Club planted seeds as a club service project at the Middle School.

Beverley's Success Club at Armin Jahr Elementary will hold their last meeting next Friday with a pizza party.

Bev's \$145.00 budget for the youth picnic scheduled for May 24, 2016, at Kiwanis Park was approved.

The Satellite Club meets the second Tuesday of each month.

Other Business:

The \$1,000 Alex Bennett Scholarship will be presented at the youth picnic.

Sunny announced the Friends of Kiwanis Park clean-up will take place May 28, 2016.

Board meeting minutes continued:

The 2016 PNW Region 4 Club Leadership Education meeting will take place Saturday, June 18, 2016, at St. Anthony Hospital in Gig Harbor. A motion was approved for the club to cover the \$35.00 registration fee for each club attendee.

On Tuesday May 24, 2016 Bob Morgan, Chris Funke and Bill Enger will be assisting students at the STEM Academy in preparing their pinewood derby cars for a race.
